

2017 Small Reach Regatta Launching Instructions

Notes:

Atlantic Boat Company is a working yard that has graciously allowed us to use their facilities. Please be watchful of yard traffic – Atlantic Boat Company vehicles and personnel have the right-of-way in all cases. The same is true of Atlantic Boat Company customers, especially at the launch ramp.

Check-in hours will be between 9 AM and 4 PM. We encourage early arrivals (this is an all-tides launch ramp). If you will arrive later than 4 PM, it is OK to self-launch, just check-in with Paul LaBrie at the campground afterwards.

(1) The entrance to Atlantic Boat Company is on Flye Point Road, approximately 1.7 miles from route 175. Turn right into the yard at the Atlantic Boat sign and proceed toward the check-in spot.

(2) Stop at the check-in. If there are cars/boats ahead of you, please feel free to start prepping your boat for launch.

(3) After check-in, turn into the staging area and prepare your boat for launch. The safety inspection will be done at this time when you are ready.

(4) When given the go-ahead to proceed, go the ramp and launch your boat. You can tie up at the dock for a short time while you move your trailer to the storage area. If the staging area is busy, you may be asked to move your vehicle to one of the overflow areas.

Chase boats will be there to transport folks back to the dock after anchoring your boat (see separate anchoring instructions). Hand-carry boats will have a spot on shore near the ramp.

After launch and anchoring, proceed to Ocean Campground at Reach Knolls. Personnel will be there to assist you.
