FORMAT: 3 MILE RACE: Single start, vessels scored individually. Single or multiple rowers, scullers or paddlers. Stern sculling tournament will follow a prediction bracket style and will be shown at skippers meeting.

COURSE: The 3 Mile race course will be set with orange marks, first leg being Lermon Cove start line at the Apprenticeshop dock to breakwater light mark, second leg being breakwater light mark to Jameson Point mark and third and last leg being Jameson Point mark to finish line at the Apprenticeshop dock. Paddleboards will complete a shortened course. The Stern Sculling tournament will accommodate several straight course races of 25 meters.

RULES: Will follow US Coast Guard Colregs. Collisions will disqualify the vessel. Races are scored on the low point system.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: 3 MILE RACE will present the following awards: Single rowing, Team Rowing, Kayak (single and tandem combined), Paddle. The Sculling Tournament will present an overall first prize.

SAFETY: USCG Approved PFDs are mandatory for all participants. The Apprenticeshop has PFDs available to borrow.

LAUNCHING VESSELS: All participants must supply their own boats for the 3 mile race. Vessels may be launched between 9AM on Friday, September 26th and 8:30AM on Saturday, September 27th. Dock and trailer parking space is limited and available on a first come, first serve basis. Please call the Main Office at 207-594-1800 to arrange dock space and/or trailer parking. Free, limited street parking is available within walking distance.

LOCATION/DIRECTIONS: The Apprenticeshop 655 Main Street Rockland, ME 04841. Heading north on RT 1, just past Dunkin Donuts on the right. Heading South on RT1, just past Claws on the left. Bosun's Locker is situated on the head of our pier and our water access ramp is right beside it. The course will be set on Rockland Harbor passing close to the Breakwater Lighthouse.
